- Facilitating reasonable adjustments

Reasonable adjustments might include

- Liaising with the multidisciplinary team regarding the patient's needs
- Practical support on the day of the procedure
- Tours of the hospital / meeting with clinicians prior to the appointment
- Reserved Parking
- Support for carers
- Change of appointments
- Longer appointment times
