Change to sterilisation referral criteria

The CCG has decided that sterilisation should be excluded from the health optimisation policy. Surgeons will be able to consider the risks and benefits of sterilisation procedures with their patients where their BMI>30. The Haxby Vasectomy Service is both aware and supportive of this change.

Female sterilisation – it is recommended that advice and guidance is sought first where BMI is above 35 as routine laparoscopy is not normally undertaken and the appropriateness of surgery is at the discretion of the surgical team.
