Hear how the proposed HEE Academy of Advanced Clinical Practice (ACP) are:

- Developing and supporting national roles which are transferable

- Establishing a robust credentialing process for each ACP pathway
- Developing an equivalence route to credentialing for existing practitioners
- Ensuring a register is in place, and the required clinical governance process, for each ACP pathway
