**What:** NIHR Clinical Research Network (CRN) are hosting a follow up event to their practice research forum that took place in March. The agenda to this event can be found through this <u>link</u>, and includes updates on the upcoming CANAssess study around palliative care and ATTACK (Aspirin To Target Arterial events in Chronic Kidney Disease) study.

#### Genetic Links to Anxiety and Depression (GLAD) Study: Poster

The CRN Yorkshire and Humber are inviting practices to display the poster for their GLAD study. This will allow your patients to 'self-register' to this Mental Health study. There are no site payments involved however the accruals will be mapped to your site. Anyone aged 16 years or older who has experienced depression and/ or anxiety (including OCD, BDD, and other related disorders) can join this study to facilitate future research. Participants will also join a national Mental Health BioResource and contribute to the largest ever single study of anxiety and depression.

All enrolment takes place online at <u>www.gladstudy.org.uk</u>. An online animation explains the consent process with more detailed information in text format. Once participants have provided consent and completed an online questionnaire, they will be sent a saliva DNA sample kit to enable genetic studies. All samples are managed by the study team.

There are no Service Support Costs allocated to this study. Accruals will be mapped to the GP site. In the case that the participants medical notes need to be reviewed at a later date the study team has provided confirmation that there will be funding allocated for this activity.
