Nursing Associate Course- Beginning March 2020

Coventry University Scarborough is seeking applications for their Nursing Associate course that begins in March 2020. This course is a two-year apprenticeship that provides career progression for Healthcare/Care Assistants and opportunities for to strengthen their nursing care delivery; further information about the course can be found through the attachment.

Employers that enrol their staff onto the March cohort will also take advantage of thousands of pounds of dedicated funding from Health Education England that may not be available from April 2020. Additional advice and resource support will also be provided by the Excellence Centre. The deadline for applications is **Friday 28 February 2020**; all you need to do to apply is complete the attached application form and return to CU Scarborough at <u>apprenticeships.cus@coventry.ac.uk</u>

As a minimum to apply your staff member will require the following:

• Level 2 English and Maths GCSE or equivalent.

• 104 UCAS points from Level 3 qualifications i.e. A Level/ BTEC or equivalent professional experience (determined by CV and Job description).
