Nabumetone 500mg Tablets Tier 2 – medium impact* Date of issue: 03/08/2020

Summary

- Tillomed Laboratories Ltd., sole suppliers of nabumetone 500mg tablets, are out of stock until 1st September 2020
- Unlicensed supplies of nabumetone 500mg tablets can be sourced, lead times vary
- UKMi have provided clinical advice on prescribing in the absence of nabumetone

Actions Required

Where patients have insufficient supplies of nabumetone tablets to last until the re-supply date, clinicians/prescribers should:

- review patients to determine if continued analgesia is still required and if so, whether treatment with a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) remains appropriate.
 - If NSAID treatment is considered appropriate, either;
 - consider prescribing unlicensed imports if nabumetone is indicated.
 Prescribers should work with local pharmacy teams to ensure orders are placed within appropriate time frames as lead times may vary (see supporting information below); or
 - consider an alternative NSAID treatment option (see supporting information below)
- if the above options are not considered appropriate, refer to BNF for consideration of other analgesics.

Clinical Information

- If an NSAID is considered necessary, switch to a non-selective or COX-2 selective NSAID, with/without gastroprotection, depending on individual risk of gastrointestinal adverse events.

Guidance on ordering and prescribing unlicensed imports

- The following specialist importers have confirmed they can source unlicensed *nabumetone 500mg tablets* (please note there may be other companies that can also source supplies):
 - Älium Medical
 - Mawdsleys Unlicensed
 - Target Healthcare
- Any decision to prescribe an unlicensed medicine must consider the relevant guidance and NHS Trust or local governance procedures. Please see the links below for further information:

- When prescribing a product that is not licensed in the UK due to a supply issue with the licensed alternative prescribers must indicate on the FP10 prescription that an unlicensed product is required. This can be done by annotating the prescription with the following wording: "**special order**".
