Important Information



Lookout for incorrect T34 Battery

Please be aware that there are some batteries being used within the Trust that should <u>not</u> be used with the T34 Ambulatory Syringe Pump.



Information provided from EME:

These batteries (PROCELL, as pictured) although 6LR61 are significantly smaller both in length and width, even with the pad fitted the terminals are losing contact causing issues with the infusion.

If you remove the battery cover on the T34 and turn upside down the battery actually falls out, whereas the NX ones are a tight fit.

If you do come across the PROCELL within your area then please do not use them on the T34. The NX is the battery of choice.

Please note that purchasing have been made aware of the issue with this particular PROCELL battery
