Opportunity for Learning Disability and Autism Project in the New Nurse-Led Innovation Programme for 2021

The Queens Nursing Institute (QNI) has received funding from the Burdett Trust for Nursing to run a new programme specifically focusing on people with complex needs in primary care. The application process is now OPEN. The deadline for completed applications is **5 pm on 30 October 2020**.

Your application must focus on the health improvement for people with complex needs in a primary care setting and include a focus on the avoidance of unplanned hospital admissions. Your project will need to focus on people experiencing complex health conditions, which may include poor physical and mental health and complex

social needs. This will include people who experience nursing services in one or more of the following settings:

- At home
- In the community (e.g. a primary or secondary school)
- In a residential or care home
- In prison
- In General Practice.

Applications from nurses looking to utilise digital technology and remote monitoring of health conditions are encouraged, as well as innovative approaches to supporting people to be cared for at home.
