

Arriving Home Safely

Guidance for ALL frontline staff including assessors working with ANYBODY regardless of COVID-19 status.



Before leaving work

Wash your hands and change out of your work clothes if possible.



In the car

Wipe down your steering wheel, controls, gear stick and door handles.



Entering your house

If possible, have somebody open your front door from the inside. Maintain social distancing of 2 metres away.



Use a plastic box by your front door for your coat, shoes and bag.

Place any belongings you use for work or your commute into the plastic box. This may include shoes, coat, bag, pens, diary, your ID badge, laptop or your work mobile. Wipe items and the box down with a damp soapy cloth.



Keeping your mobile phone clean

When at work, keep your mobile phone in a clear, sealed ziplock bag. When you get home, remove the bag and throw it away.



Your work bag

Use a machine washable bag. Where possible, leave your bag in a locker at work. When you get home, leave it in the box near your door.



Go straight to the bathroom to wash

Without touching anything, go straight to the bathroom and shower/wash. Use hot water and soap to clean your hands, arms and face.

You are now clean

It is now safe for you to relax and enjoy the rest of your day. Thank you for all of the hard work as one of our key workers.
