The CCG does not separately contract for the provision of the telephony system we use on our two sites. For the West Offices site the telephony system is part of the building rental arrangements with City of York Council and cannot be separately identified. For our Amy Jonson Way site the telephony system is part of the overall IT support from our commissioning support service provider North of England Commissioning Support.
