### **Your Request for Information**

I am writing in response to your recent request that we received on 25 November 2020 in which you requested the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

### **Information Requested**

Can I request that the following questions are answered under Freedom of Information.

1. When was Stoma Appliance Management last discussed at Board / Governing Body?
2. Please provide the board pack and minutes.
3. Who is your lead for Stoma Appliance and accessories?
4. What is their email address?
5. Do you operate a centralised Stoma service?  
If yes:
  - 5a. Who provides the service?
  - 5b. What are the contract start/end/review dates?
  - 5c. What is the contract value per year?
  - 5d. What is the total net cost of prescribing or supply of appliances for stoma.
  - 5e. Does the CCG have any rebates in place with any companies for stoma products? If yes please provide product names, start dates and contract lengths.
