## The NHS is currently offering the COVID-19 vaccine to people most at risk from coronavirus. There is no need for patients to get in touch with their GP surgery

 their surgery will contact individuals when it's their turn. The vaccine is being offered in some hospitals and increasing numbers of local vaccination centres in North Yorkshire and York run by GP surgeries. The jab is

currently being rolled out to all those aged 80 and over, along with frontline

health and care workers and care home residents. People aged 75 and over and then all those who are 70 and over, together with clinically extremely vulnerable patients will follow. Read more. People are warned to be alert to these scams. The vaccine is only available from the NHS and the NHS will contact you when it is your turn. The NHS will:

NEVER ask you to press a button on your keypad or send a text asking

If you receive a suspicious message, forward it to 7726 to report it.

• NEVER ask for payment for the vaccine or for your bank details.
