#### **WORKFORCE & TRAINING SCHEMES**

As a Primary Care Workforce and Training Hub (formerly known as Advanced Training Practice (ATP) Hub) in Humber Coast & Vale we are able to provide training support for local practices. We coordinate local schemes on behalf of Health Education England. This includes aiding practices to develop mentors/assessors, offer student placements and employ and train a variety of roles.

#### > Student Nurses in General Practice

- ✓ Offers support for practices and nurse mentors/assessors/supervisors to take undergraduate student nurses on placement
- ✓ The aim is to increase access to general practice placements for student nurses, to promote practice nursing as a career and help secure the primary care workforce of the future
- ✓ Great recruitment tool and professional development opportunity for staff
- ✓ Practices receive a tariff to support time for mentorship and coordination
- ✓ Funding available for nurses to undertake the mentorship/assessor course

#### New to Practice Nurse VTS Scheme

- ✓ Offers support for practices to employ and train a newly-qualified or new-to-practice nurse.
- ✓ Includes a programme of weekly teaching and training sessions.
- ✓ Currently participating practices can access a bursary.
- ✓ Coordinated on a cohort basis usually starting around February once funding has been confirmed for 2021/22 information for Expressions of Interest will be circulated.

#### > TNA Ready Scheme

- Applications are ongoing subject to university course availability, please ask for more details.

#### > ACP Ready Scheme

- ✓ Offers support for practices to employ and train an Advanced Clinical Practitioner over their first two years whilst working towards completing the MSc in Advanced Clinical Practice
- ✓ Currently participating practices can access a training grant plus funded course fees for a recognised MSc in Advanced Clinical Practice. This is mainly now via the apprenticeship route.
- ✓ Suitable for Registered Nurses or Allied Health Professionals such as Paramedics, Physiotherapists and Pharmacists developing advanced clinical roles in primary care
- ✓ Includes regular group peer-support/learning sessions.

#### > PA Ready Scheme

- ✓ Offers support and funding for practices to employ a new Physician Associate
- ✓ Includes regular group peer-support/learning sessions.

#### > HCA Ready Scheme (HCA Apprenticeship Scheme)

- ✓ Offers support for practices to employ and train an Apprentice HCA, including a programme of study days and a Level 3 diploma in Healthcare Support over 18 months.
- ✓ Coordinated on a cohort basis usually starting around September. Funding for 2021/22 to be confirmed, if/when available invites for Expressions of Interest will be shared.

#### CPD for Primary Care
