COURSES - FUNDING

- Course Fees – Levy Funding 100% or Reserved Funding 95%
- Additional Support – HEE - £8,000 (£4,000 per year) if LD £15,800 (£7,900 per year)
- Sourcing Levy Funding – Humber, Coast and Vale Workforce Consortium
- DAS account
