## Selby Hospital In-patient Unit

Selby inpatient unit is a 20 bed facility, with an additional 2 beds for bariatric patients, on the top floor of Selby Hospital. It provides multidisciplinary care for patients with the team consisting of nursing staff, doctors, 2 physiotherapists and 2 occupational therapists with pharmacy support.

The main patients we look after are those with **rehabilitation goals**, **complex discharges** and those requiring **palliative care**.

Patients can be transferred here from YDH as a **step down towards home** and we also accept community patients who are being **stepped up** as a direct admission.

The ward is covered with medical staff between 9-3pm Monday to Friday with provision from the OOH GP at other times. During these hours we are able to clerk in new admissions and prescribe their medications. We ask that patients arrive before 2pm so this can be completed on the same day. We have a morning board round and following this most patients are seen by the therapy team each day and are reviewed by the medical team if required. Dr Ronan does a ward round once a week, usually a Thursday, where all patients are assessed.

We are keen to better facilitate community step up patients; both the nursing and medical staff are able to accept patients directly, providing there is a side room available so a patient can be isolated while we wait for their covid-19 results to return. We are available to contact on the phone numbers below. Medical staff should be available to discuss patients during the hours above and nursing staff outside of these hours. We are also available over the phone on a Thursday between 12-1pm to discuss anything you require – recent discharges, new admissions, general frailty queries etc.
