




Ensure the carbonated copy is below the original when writing the DNACPR form.




Complete a mental capacity assessment, if patient lacks capacity



Complete **DNACPR** sticker and place in medical admission notes



Complete ceiling of care (CoC) on inpatient care record on CPD.




