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What is Happening?

- On 1 July the Health and Care Bill will come into force, and all Clinical Commissioning Group's (CCG's) will cease to exist and their powers will transfer to Integrated Care Systems (ICS'S) covering a larger geographical footprint.

What Will Happen in Our Area?

- NHS Humber and North Yorkshire Integrated Care Board (ICB) will become the statutory body responsible NHS functions and budgets across 1.7 million people in our area- Taking on the responsibilities formerly held by the below:

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What is an ICS?

ICS's have been introduced to promote collaborative working between the NHS, local councils, the voluntary and community sector, other health and care and public sector organisations and our local communities. Joint working has been underpinned by a shared belief that we are more successful in bringing about change and improving the lives of our local populations if we work together. The vision for our population is:

'in everything we do, we are helping local people to start well, live well and age well'

- Tackle inequalities in outcomes, experience and access
 - Enhance productivity and value for money
- Help the NHS support broader social and economic development.
 - Our populations should see that together we are:
