

The Impacts of Climate Change on Adults in need of Care and Support: Service, Carer and Care User Perspectives and Responses.

This study is looking at how flooding caused by climate change is impacting on social care for adults in England. It aims to find out what effect climate change including related flooding is having on care homes. It will cover people's expectations of flood events, preparedness and any support systems in place. From staff they would like to understand how care home flooding is prevented, and how people feel about flood planning, before, during and after an event. This also includes experiences of changes in weather, including the challenges of keeping residents cool.
