#### **Care Homes COVID-19 Admissions- Update for Providers**

The Community Infection Prevention Control Team have put together an <u>update</u> for providers shared at this weeks Care Connected, providing guidance for admitting residents during a COVID-19 outbreak. This covers the expectations around testing on discharge, and guidance on the risk assessment and the need to take account of factors including size of outbreak, care environment and uptake of booster vaccinations. The guidance for providers is that:

- The registered manager can accept the admission, providing the risk assessment indicates it is safe to do so.
- Care home providers must be able to refuse admissions where they feel they cannot provide safe care and they must not be put under undue pressure

# New Study to Examine Asymptomatic Testing of Care Home Staff for COVID-19

NHS Test and Trace is carrying out a study called VIVALDI-CT to examine the health impact of asymptomatic testing of care home staff for COVID-19. The aim is to make sure future testing policies protect the sector from COVID-19 and other respiratory illnesses. University College London are looking to recruit 280 care homes for the study where staff will either be asked to take regular lateral flow device tests or simply follow the testing guidance in place at the time. #### **Trusted Assessor Form Care Provider Engagement Event**

York and Scarborough Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust are leading work to improve the quality of information contained within Trusted Assessment Forms (TAFs), which are the supporting documents sent to providers when a patient is deemed as medically optimised and fit for discharge. The aim of the improvement work is to support providers to speed up their decision making around accepting a person into a residential / nursing establishment or for a package of care in the person's own home.

The aim of this improvement work is to reduce the number of delays at the acute hospital sites, who are under the extreme pressures due to delays in discharging people at the right time. As part of this work, we would like to offer our providers a voice in this work and the chance to engage in the development of a 'gold standard TAF'. Therefore we are hosting engagements on the below dates open to all providers from across our area, as a chance to discuss openly your experiences of receiving these forms, and the content you would like to see to support your service in accepting discharges.
