## Safeguarding Adults Level 3 Initial training

# For Primary Care 2024-2025:

## **Target Audience**

**Two x 2.5 hour** virtual sessions **via Microsoft Teams** for all level 3 practice staff (GP's, Practice Nurses, Advanced Nurse Practitioners, Paramedics) requiring **Initial level 3 Safeguarding Adults** training as per the Adult Safeguarding: Roles and Competencies for Health Care Staff and RCGP supplementary guide: <u>Safeguarding-training-requirements-for-Primary-Care-FINAL.pdf (rcgp.org.uk)</u>



Initial training refers to the **first time** that a professional is in a role that requires Level 3 Adults safeguarding training. The timeframe for this initial training should not exceed a 12-month period from commencing in post. This training is 5 hours of participatory learning. Guidance states that 8 hours of level 3 training is required for competence. The additional required hours on Adult Safeguarding can be boosted by accessing further Level 3 safeguarding training such as our 'Hot topics' sessions; our safeguarding week presentations, e-learning and completing further reading around the safeguarding subjects that we will direct you to during the sessions.

- Statutory requirements of the Care Act 2014 in relation to Adult Safeguarding
- Definitions and types and indicators of abuse
- Roles & responsibilities of the Safeguarding Adult Board
- Mental Capacity Act/Advocacy and Making Safeguarding Personal
- Role of health staff in the safeguarding adult process
