Essity – Digital Transformation Update





Essity is making significant strides in accelerating the digital transformation. By implementing cutting-edge technologies and innovative solutions, we aim to enhance services for both our valued customers and consumers.

In September 2024, Essity will introduce a new digital platform, which includes a Systems, Applications, and data Products (SAP) upgrade.

During the transition, there will be a brief 4-day period (Thursday through Sunday) when our main SAP system will temporarily close. Rest assured the Indigo Home Delivery system will continue to function during this time. However, as the connection between Indigo and our main SAP will be temporarily disconnected for 2 working days, we anticipate a slight extended delivery time for <u>new</u> patients added to Indigo on Thursday & Friday. Detailed plans to mitigate any immediate new patient needs will be communicated early August.

Once the new SAP platform is live, the way Essity collaborates with you through Indigo will remain unchanged.

Additionally, Essity is proactively planning to maintain additional safety stock in our UK warehouses. This measure will address any unexpected supply issues and further demonstrate our commitment to reliable service.

Thank you for your continued partnership as we embark on this exciting digital journey together.
