August 18 Summary

- In the North Region, **88.7%** of patients on the incomplete pathway waited less than 18 weeks in August 2018, this is below the national standard of 92.0% and is 0.3% less than the previous month. Nationally 87.2% was reported.
- 1,091,378 patients were reported as being on the waiting list, this is 1.4% more than the previous month where the list was 1,075,885.
- 123,334 patients are waiting over 18 weeks for treatment, this is 4.6% more than the 117,859 waiting in the previous month.
- 759 patients in the North are waiting over 52 weeks, 112 fewer than the previous month.
- North Region providers reporting '52 day waiters' include: 295 at Northern Lincolnshire and Goole, 164 at Leeds Teaching, 150 at Manchester University, 56 at Wirral, 49 at Lancashire, 32 at Blackpool, 30 at Pennine Acute, 21 at Liverpool Women's, 16 at Hull & East Yorkshire, 14 at Bradford, 10 at Bolton, 7 at Stockport, 4 at Doncaster & Bassetlaw, 3 at Countess of Chester, 2 at Morecambe Bay and 1 each at Gateshead, Royal Liverpool and Broadgreen and Southport & Ormskirk.
- It would take the North Region 13.2 weeks to clear the waiting list as it stands in August 2018 and 1.5 weeks to clear the backlog (those waiting over 18 weeks).
- There are 24 Providers in the North which are reported as failing the 92% standard in August 2018, one more than the previous month.
